With financial support for our partners and sponsors, GCC delivers a 24/7 online grants platform that helps not-for-proft organisations fund their programs, making the Geelong region a better place.

## Why Support Geelong Connected Communities?

GCC has a primary focus on supporting smaller not-for-profit organisations that are under-supported and mostly managed by volunteers looking to put back into their community.

Grant programs reach a broad cross section of the community as they're delivered across ten categories: Arts and Culture, Events, Sport, Diversity and Inclusion, Health and Wellbeing, Environment, Youth, Community Sponsorship, Community Safety and Community Projects.

Our partners and sponsors can direct requests for support from community organisations to GCC knowing the governance structure is designed to manage those processes effectively, delivering value to the business and the community.

GCC's structure and policies have been developed to make us easy to deal with, transparent in our practices and quick to respond to requests for support.

GCC's financial supporters are kept well informed on the progress of our grant programs, and a maximum percentage of their investment is contributed directly to a local community program.

GCC has a relationship with over 300 not-for-profit organisations in the Geelong region, who we have assisted with more than 700 projects, distributing over \$2million.

GCC's detailed acquittal program provides data on the impact of our grants program, including that we have reached over 100,000 people in local communities.

GCC's website and social media platform provide excellent recognition of our partners and sponsors.

GCC's passionate and talented Board of Directors volunteer their time to ensure a no fuss, efficient organisational structure.
